Quality Indicator Survey Process

The Quality Indicator Survey (QIS) is a revised long-term care survey process developed under CMS oversight. The process was designed to improve surveyor consistency and accuracy using a more structured process, comprehensively review requirements within current resources, enhance documentation through automation, and focus survey resources according to the number of quality concerns. The QIS involves an initial review of larger samples of residents through observations, interviews, and clinical record reviews. Using laptop computers, survey findings from Stage I are combined with MDS data to provide rates on a comprehensive set of Quality of Care Indicators (QCIs). Stage II provides the structure for the in-depth investigation and documentation of the triggered Care Areas and associated regulations for a sample of residents. The QIS software facilitates team analysis and decision-making of the surveyor findings. Although the QIS revised the process in which surveyors gather and analyze findings, the federal regulations and guidance to surveyors remain the same. This workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to increase their understanding of the QIS process, and prepare you for the ultimate national implementation of this process.

Peggy Williams has over 20 years experience in long-term care as an interdisciplinary team member, consultant, surveyor, speaker, and educator/trainer. She facilitated team assessment and care planning as a social service coordinator and social work consultant for nursing homes in Rapid City, SD. Peggy served as a subject matter expert in the development of the Quality Indicators for the CMS Nursing Home Case-Mix and Quality demonstration, pilot testing of a revised survey process using the Quality Indicators, and on the CMS panel for revising the guidance to surveyors for tags F323 and F324. Her more recent long-term care experience has been as a clinical trainer and project manager for the CMS Quality Indicator Survey (QIS) project. Her final Master's project researched perspectives on survey agency collaboration with the long-term care culture change movement. Peggy is also a certified Eden Associate.
